To Provide Snow Plowing Service to fire stations

Background

Tri-Lakes Monument Fire Protection District (DBA Monument Fire District) requests proposals from qualified snow removal companies for all five of our fire stations.

Station Locations-Station 1, 18650 Hwy 105, Monument

Station 2, 18460 Rollercoaster Road, Monument

Station 3, 1855 Woodmoor Drive, Monument

Station 4, 15415 Gleneagle Drive, Colorado Springs

Station 5, 15055 State Hwy 83, Black Forest

Scope of the Work

Work requires the spreading and installing of ice melt. Buckets of ice melt are to be filled at each station. Plow to occur every 4 inches of snow or as needed throughout a storm. Plow to occur in the parking lot of each station and the entire driveway in front of each bay door at each fire station.

Insurance Requirement

General Liability \$1,000,000 per occurrence

\$2,000,000 per general aggregate

Auto Liability \$1,000,000 combined single limit.

Workers Compensation

Insurance must extend to all subcontractors and automotive equipment used in the performance of the job and must list the District as an additional Insured.
