



CSPD BURN RESTRICTION GUIDE



✓ ALLOWED



OUTDOOR COOKING

Outdoor BBQ grills that are fueled by wood, pellets, or charcoal, and/or liquid propane gas, natural gas, or liquid fuel.



OUTDOOR FIREPLACE/APPLIANCES

Any outdoor fire where the fire is contained in a portable or fixed fireplace/appliance. A spark arrestor (a device that prevents the emission of flammable debris) must be used when burning wood, pellets, or charcoal.



OUTDOOR SMOKING

Outdoor smoking in designated areas only.
NOT ALLOWED IN CITY OWNED PARKS AND OPEN SPACES.

✓ ALLOWED WITH A PERMIT



Hot work such as welding in forested or grassy areas.



Model rocket launching.



Professional fireworks displays.

✗ NOT ALLOWED



RECREATIONAL FIRES

Any outdoor fire or campfire where the fire is not contained in a portable or fixed fireplace/appliance. No permits will be issued for Bonfires during Burn Restrictions.



SMALL ENGINE EQUIPMENT

Operating small internal combustion engines such as chainsaws, **WITHOUT** a properly installed, maintained, and functioning spark arrestor (a device that prevents the emission of flammable debris).



OUTDOOR SMOKING

NO outdoor smoking in **ALL CITY OWNED PARKS AND OPEN SPACES.**

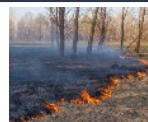
✗ PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES



Use of recreational fireworks requiring ignition (has a fuse) such as sparklers, rockets, fountains, etc.



Burning of trash or rubbish.



Any type of fire whether open or contained, on any undeveloped wildland areas, brushy areas, or grassy areas.

! MUNICIPAL SUMMONS – BURN RESTRICTION ORDER

The current Burn Restriction Order prohibits any type of fire whether open or contained, on any undeveloped wildland areas, brushy areas, or grassy areas. Officers are requested to investigate violations of this order and issue appropriate summons and complaints.
